We are writing to inform you about an important upcoming change to your prescription drug benefits for members enrolled in Anthem BlueCross Platinum Plan 2. Effective **January 1, 2025**, there will be an increase in the co-pay for certain prescription medications.

This change is part of our ongoing efforts to provide access to high-quality healthcare at an affordable cost. Our goal is to offer sustainable benefits. We understand that rising prescription drug costs can be a concern, and we want to ensure that you have all the information you need to manage these changes.

### What's Changing:

**New Copay Amounts: Beginning January 1, 2025, the copay for some prescription drugs on Tier 2 and Tier 3 will be increasing.**
